

## Literacy

We will begin by studying 'Penguins' in relation to our Arctic topic focus. We will be using lots of non-fiction organisation and language features to create our very own fact book all about penguins!

Then we will study the adventure tale of 'The Lonely Beast' and re-tell it using places we have learned about in Geography for the beast to visit on his journey to find new friends.

## RE

This term we will explore the question 'Who is Jewish and what do they believe?'

## Geography

We will be looking at weather patterns in the UK and comparing them the extreme condition of the Arctic and the desert. We will also be learning about how weather changes across seasons.

## Maths

This term we will begin by re-capping place value, this time looking at numbers to 100. We will also learn about number patterns by reviewing out counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. Then we will begin learning about multiplication and division by grouping objects and pictures. Finally we will introduce 3D shapes.

Our WOW Day will be 'Arctic Explorers' on the 14<sup>th</sup> January 2019. Children can come dressed in normal uniform but please ensure they have wellies and a coat in school as we hope to use the woodland area whatever the waether.

## DT

We will be designing and making our own penguin puppet developing our sewing skills.

## PE

This term we will be beginning our gymnastics unit exploring different ways to travel and move across equipment. We will also be taking part in some games outside therefore the children will need appropriate PE for both indoor and outdoor.

Our theme this term is 'Media'. We will paint pictures and write about them using IT equipment.

## Science

In science we will be learning about basic human needs and how to survive in different extreme conditions. Children will also learn how to stay fit and healthy and learn about the five senses.
