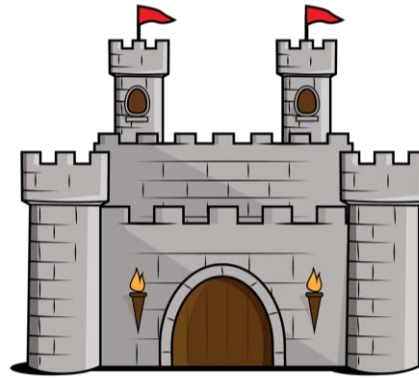
## DT
